




- 2- The graph below shows radio and television audiences throughout the day in 1992. Summarise the information by selecting and reporting the main features, and make comparisons where relevant.




**Radio and television audiences in UK, October – December 1992**






6- The bar chart shows the number of times per week (in 1000s), over five weeks, that three computer packages were downloaded from the internet.


7- The pie charts show the main reasons for migration to and from the UK in 2007. Summarize the information by selecting and reporting the main features and make comparisons where relevant.

**MAIN REASON FOR MIGRATION TO/FROM THE UK - 2007**














France Electricity Generation, 2009 (510 Billion kWh)













**Distribution of visitors to different types of tourist attractions in Britain, 1999**




**Car ownership in Canada**





**Average monthly spend on children's sports**








